

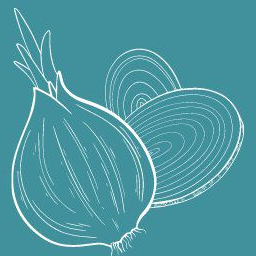
Impact of COVID-19 on Indian Agriculture

The Covid-19 pandemic has adversely impacted the incomes for half the population



Price of wheat during the lockdown fell below the Minimum Support Price, as a result, only **19%** farmers were able to sell their produce *(Development Data Lab)*

Market arrivals of onion and potato fell **48%** and **59%** respectively *(Development Data Lab)*
